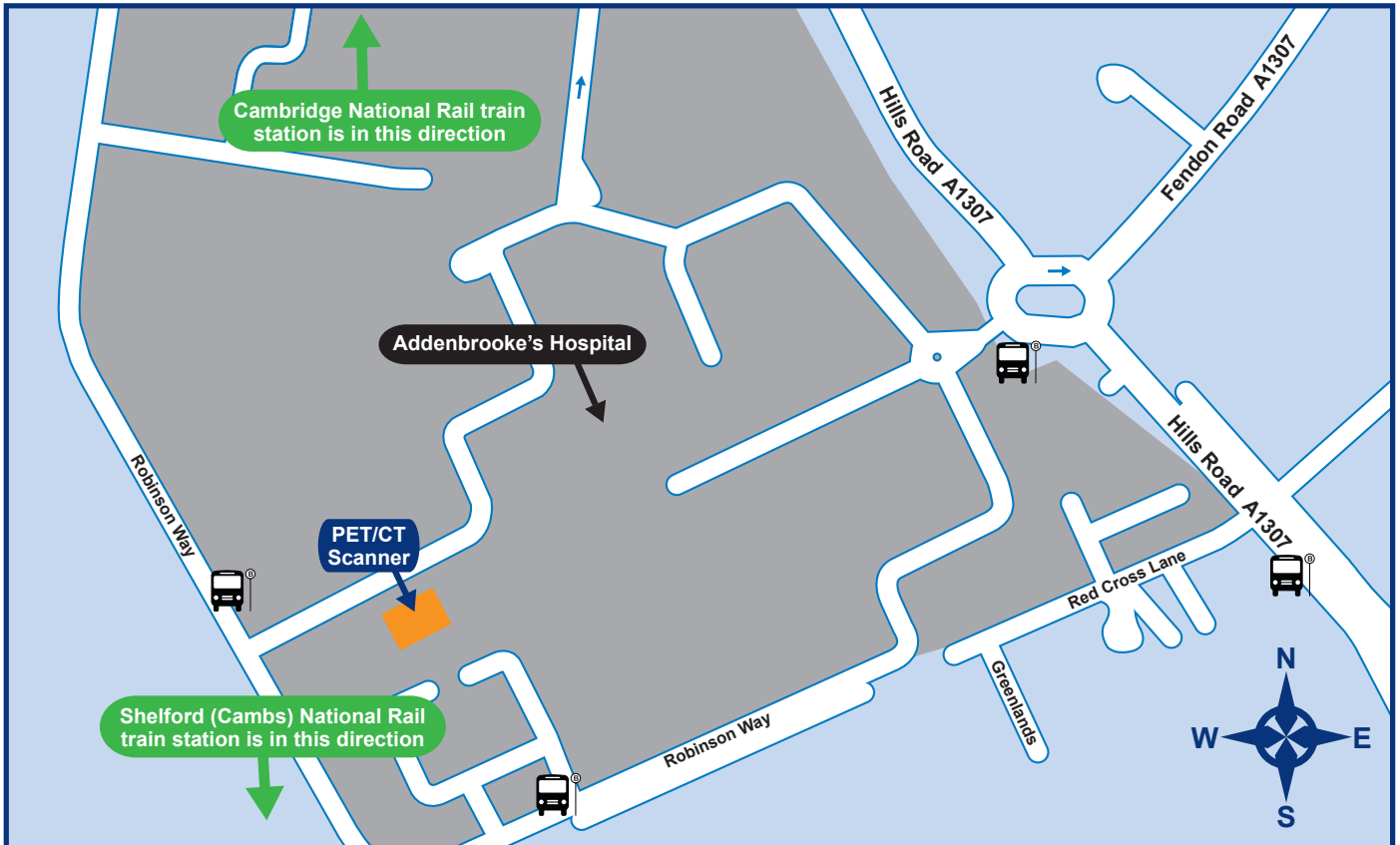


How to find Addenbrooke's Treatment Centre

By road



From the M25 take junction 27 on to the M11. At junction 11 take the road signposted Cambridge (A1309), Hauxton Road and bear left on to the High Street. Turn right on to Long Road and right on to Hills Road; the entrance to the hospital will be on your right.

The mobile NHS PET/CT Diagnostic Imaging Service is located close to the Addenbrooke's Treatment Centre (ATC). The car park closest to the mobile PET/CT is Car Park F (opposite the Addenbrooke's Treatment Centre). Currently it is under renovation but parts of Car Park F will remain open during this time. Marshals will be located at the entrance to the car park to direct you to available parking spaces. Once this refurbishment work has been completed Car Park F will be renamed as the 'Treatment Centre Car Park'.

Drop off parking is available directly outside the Treatment Centre. Parking space at Cambridge University Hospitals is limited and the nearby roads can get congested. We encourage you to use public transport, taxis or walk/cycle, if possible. A 'pay on foot' car park system operates at Cambridge University Hospitals, with patients and visitors paying to park in specially designated car parks.

All car parks at Cambridge University Hospitals have barriers at the entrances and exits. Ticket machines are located in each car park for paying and validating the car park ticket before exit. The system is very easy to use, just like many shopper's car parks in towns and cities around the country.

If you choose to come by car, please remember to bring some change for the car park ticket machines.

By rail



Trains stop at Cambridge Railway Station, which is about two miles from Addenbrooke's. There are frequent buses (every 10 minutes) from the station (Citi 1 and Citi 7) to Addenbrooke's and also a convenient taxi service. By bus

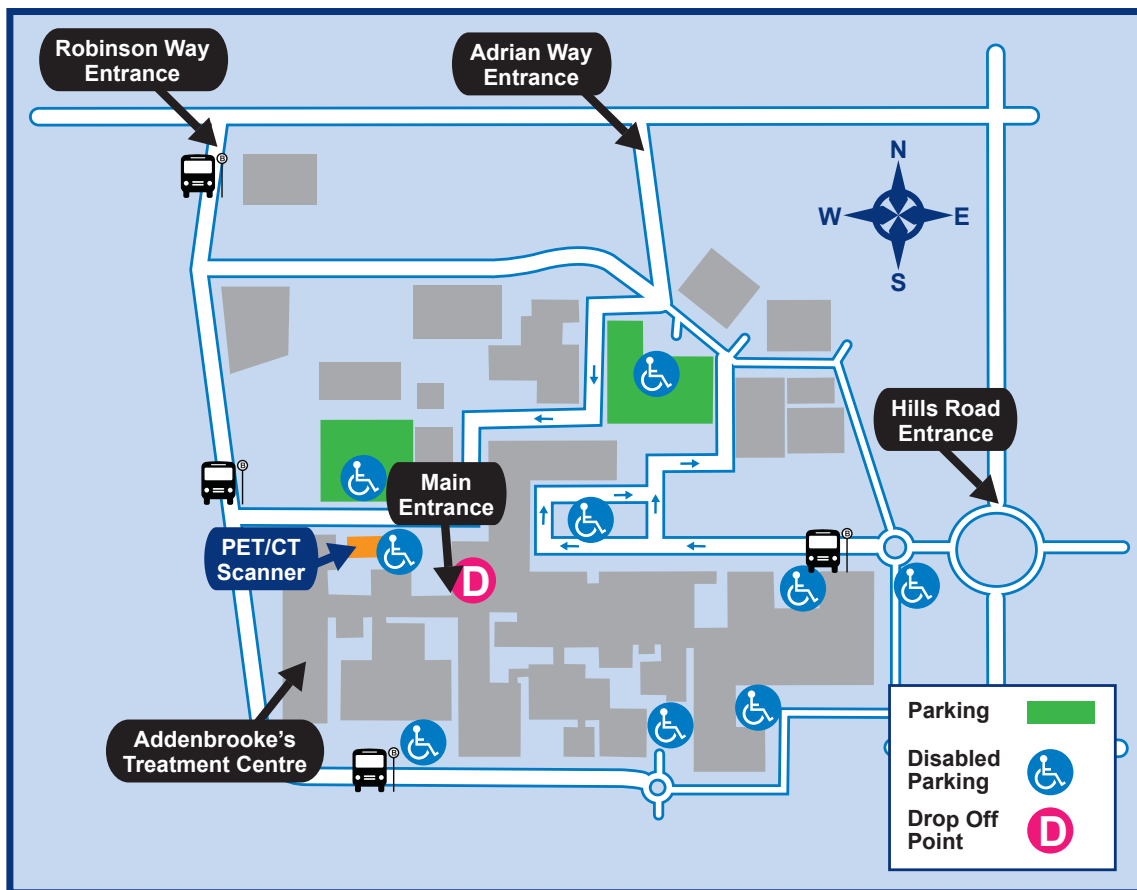


Nearly 60 buses an hour serve Addenbrooke's Hospital on weekdays, with services originating from both within the City of Cambridge and beyond.

For full timetable information please see the county council website www.cambridgeshire.gov.uk/transport/around/buses, or call Traveline on **0871 200 2 233** for regular updates.

The hospital is served by its own bus station located at the Hills Road entrance to the site. The majority of buses pick up and drop off here.

Check the site map to see where the most convenient stop is for you.



Please follow the NHS PET/CT Diagnostic Imaging Service signs, or follow the signs for Car Park F (visitors car park). The mobile site is in Car Park G. This requires crossing the road in front of F. There are ramped kerbs and a zebra crossing to allow more safe and efficient access to the mobile unit.
