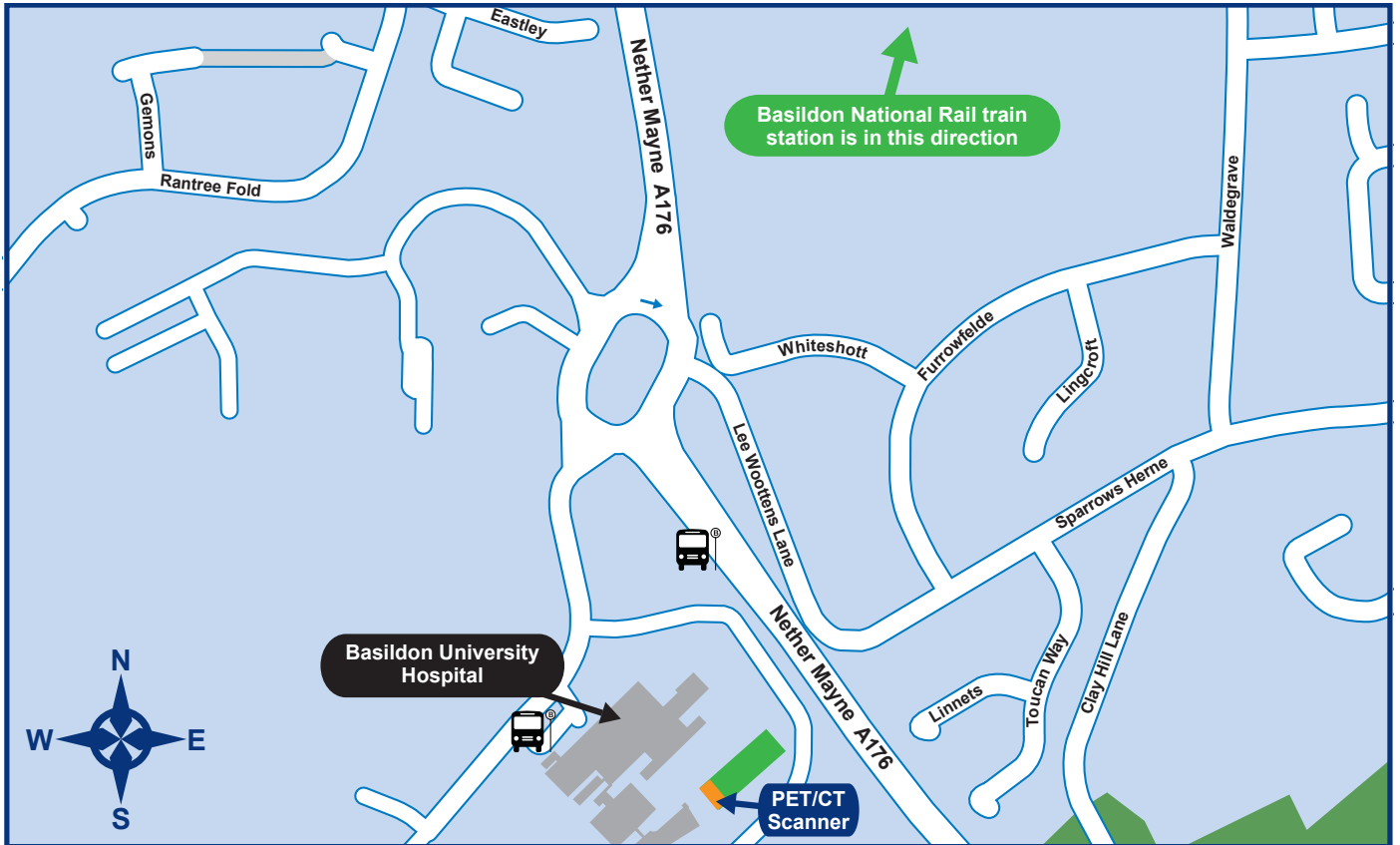


How to find Basildon University Hospital

Basildon University Hospital, Nethermayne, Basildon, Essex SS16 5NJ



By road



From the A12, take A130 signposted Basildon and continue until you reach Sadlers Farm roundabout. Take the second exit onto A13 and then take the A176 turn off. Take the Basildon exit and continue on this road, Basildon University Hospital is on your left. From the A127, take the A176 towards Basildon Town Centre, the Hospital route is clearly marked with red Hospital A&E signs. When you reach the Hospital, the Essex Cardiothoracic Centre will be signposted to the left.

Parking

The new multi-storey car park at Basildon University Hospital is now open. With 1600 spaces, the new car park has been a massive investment. Built in direct response to requests for improvements to parking, from local people, it has cost £8 million. To fund this, and the continued maintenance of the other car parks at Basildon University Hospital and Orsett Hospital, changes have been introduced to the parking charges for patients and visitors. Parking is free for the first 45 minutes, then £3 for up to 8 hours.

By bus



Bus routes serving the Hospital include 21, 25, 100 and 200.

By rail

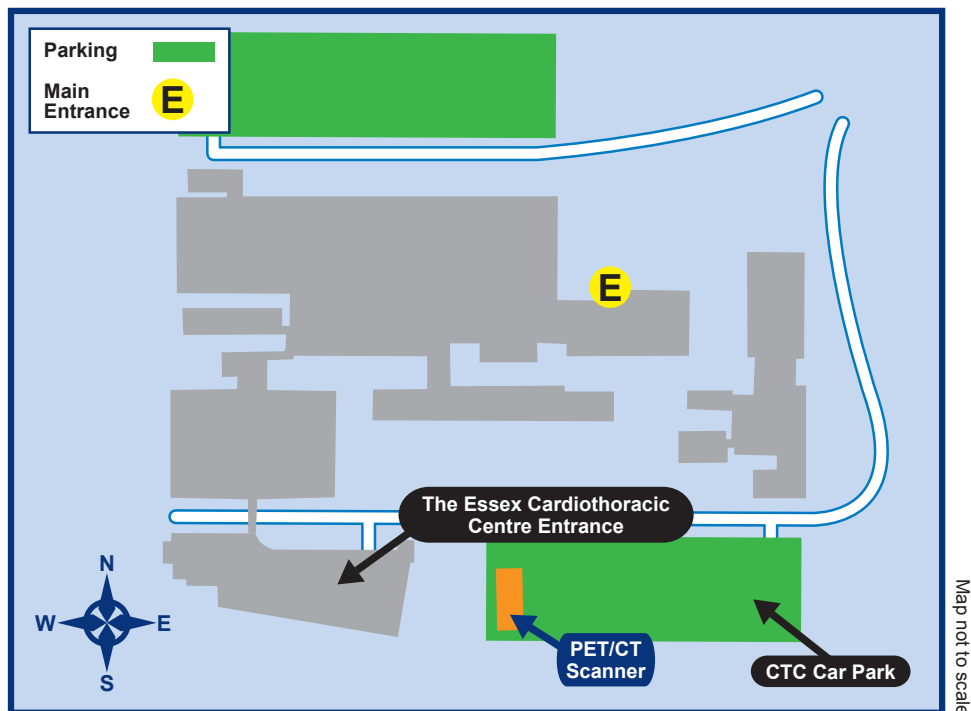


The nearest National Rail train station is Basildon and it takes 15 minutes to walk to the hospital from the station.
